Universidad de Navarra launched its Degree in Design in 2016 to train versatile and creative designers, using an innovative, project-based approach that focuses on how design can serve society. All theoretical, practical, technical and creative content is organized around and applied to projects, allowing students to learn through practice and to meet professionals in different fields. For instance "Atlantes" has students collaborate with the University Hospital's Department of Palliative Care, while those involved in «Green campus» work on improving recycling services. All projects must include the DALCO criteria (to provide an accessible environment for all). Fourth year students working on the "Inclusive project" teamed up with 3 companies to adapt their products to the needs of people with various disabilities. Integrating content and competences through projects helps students connect and understand the whole constellation of subjects, ideas and teachings this degree has to offer.
